Life at First Cutlerville CRC

We are glad that you came to First Cutlerville today. We gather in God's presence to praise, pray, and learn from God's Word - all for God's glory! Please take a moment to sign the LinkIn when passed down the row.

Thursday, March 29 is Maundy Thursday. We will celebrate the Lord's Supper at our 7:00pm worship service. Our participation in this sacrament will be through a long practiced tradition of intinction. Congregants will be invited to come to the front of the worship center, take a piece of bread, and dip it into the chalice. Those who find walking to the front of the church difficult are invited to sit in the back two rows of the two center sections; these rows will be served by passing the elements down the row.

At the Maundy Thursday worship service, the congregation is invited to participate in a handwashing ceremony, which occurs at the entrances of the worship center, and recalls Jesus washing the disciples' feet.

Easter Sunday, April 1, we will celebrate the Lord's Supper - a sacrament we participate in periodically as we remember the sacrifice and death of Jesus Christ that provides forgiveness for our sins and his life-giving nourishment. Participants are encouraged to engage in prayer and the Scripture as they prepare.

For our offering, we will pass the offering plate once. If you would like to give to the General Fund, please place your offering in an envelope found in the seats and label it General Fund. All loose offerings will go towards the day's special offering. Sunday, March 25 special offering is for Middle School Youth Group, which helps this group with expenses. The evening offering is for Christian Schools, which applies to the variance program for the church members who send their children to Christian Schools.

Prayer is an important part of life at First Cutlerville CRC. We invite you to join us for a time of prayer before the morning service in the Prayer Room. Prayer teams are also available after the morning service to pray with and for you.

To Engage our church family of all ages, we have displayed a large frame between the drinking fountains outside the sanctuary. Our goal is to pose a new question each month with various ways to share some of the responses with our church family. Use the provided materials to post your response or answer.
